

















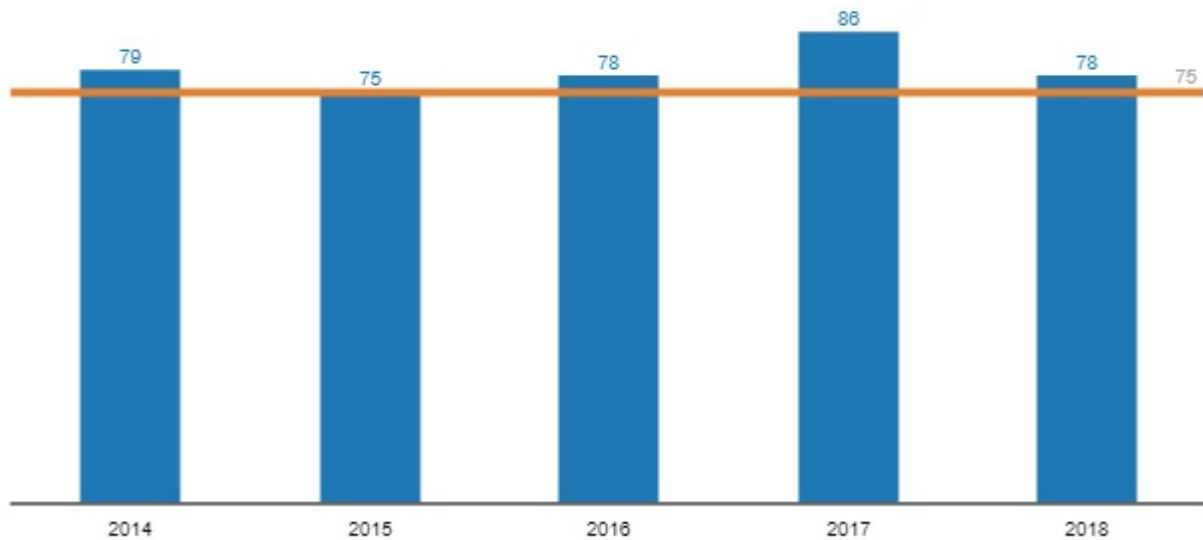

The school quality indicator for academic achievement in English provides equal credit for students who pass state English tests and for non-passing students who show significant improvement.



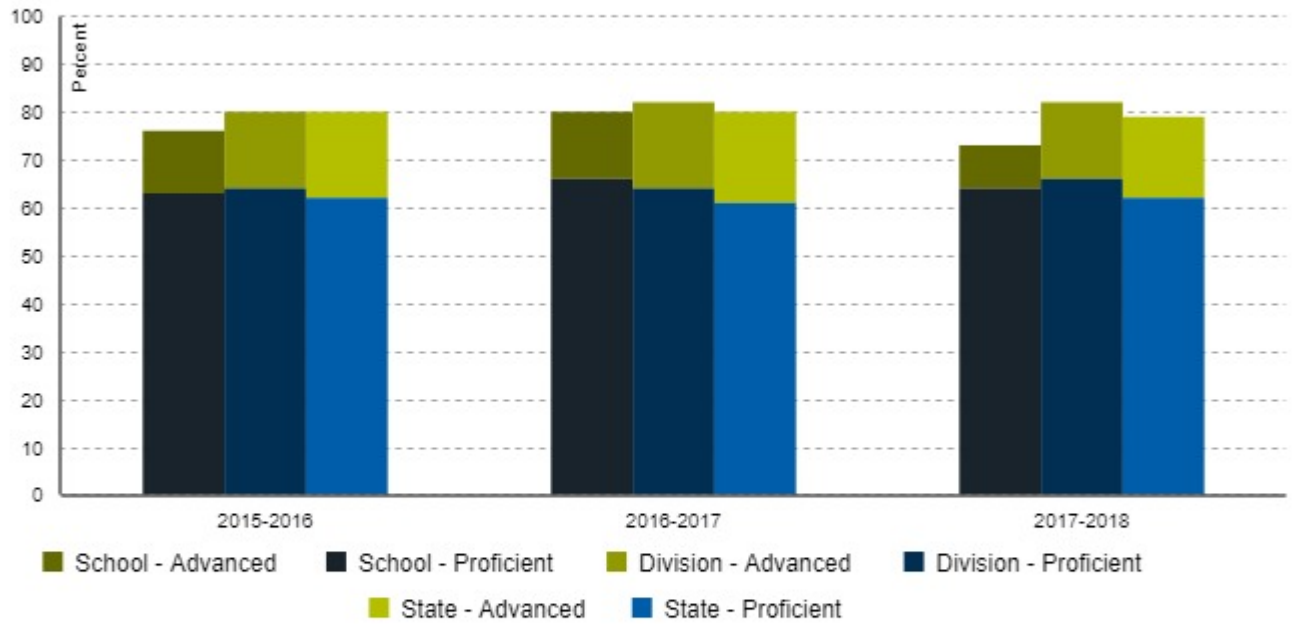
# Student Engagement and Outcomes: Chronic Absenteeism

12.18% of the students in this school were chronically absent in the 2017 - 2018 school year.

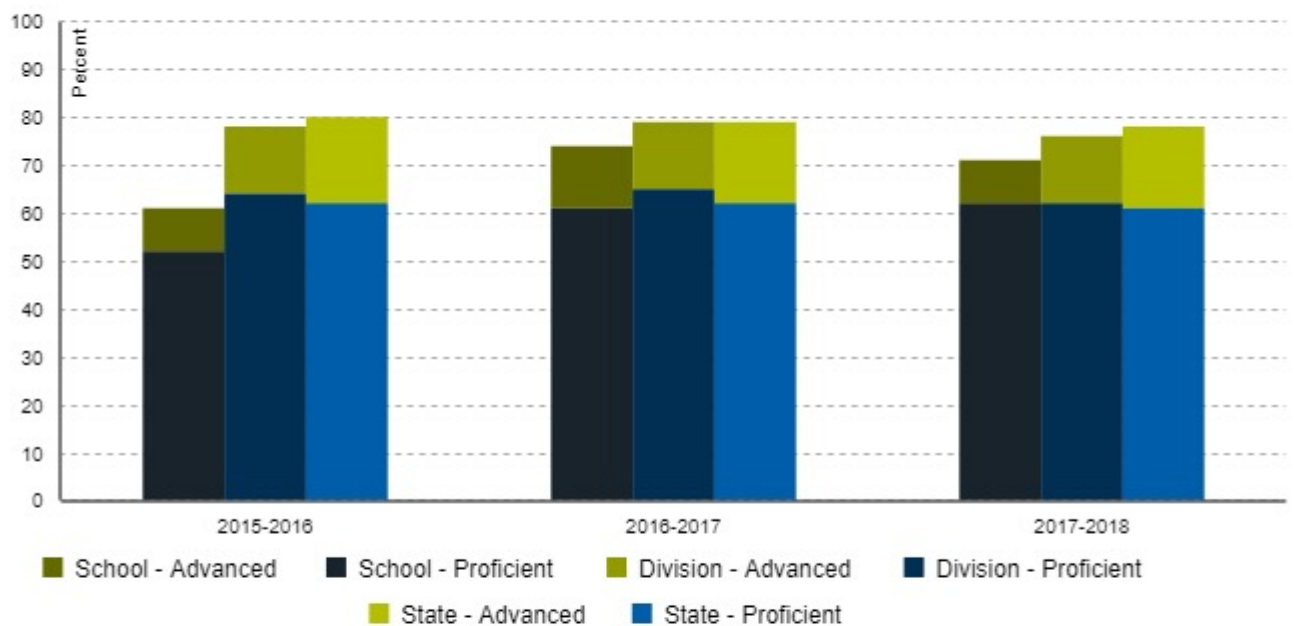

### Reading Performance: All Students



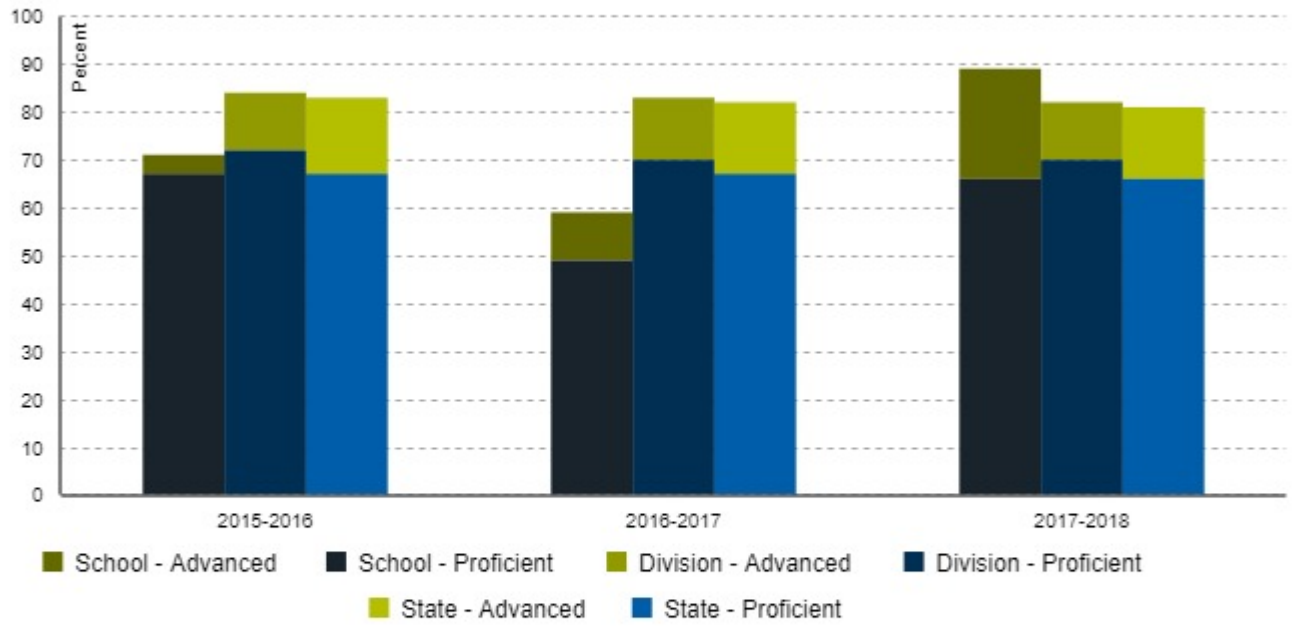

### Math Performance: All Students



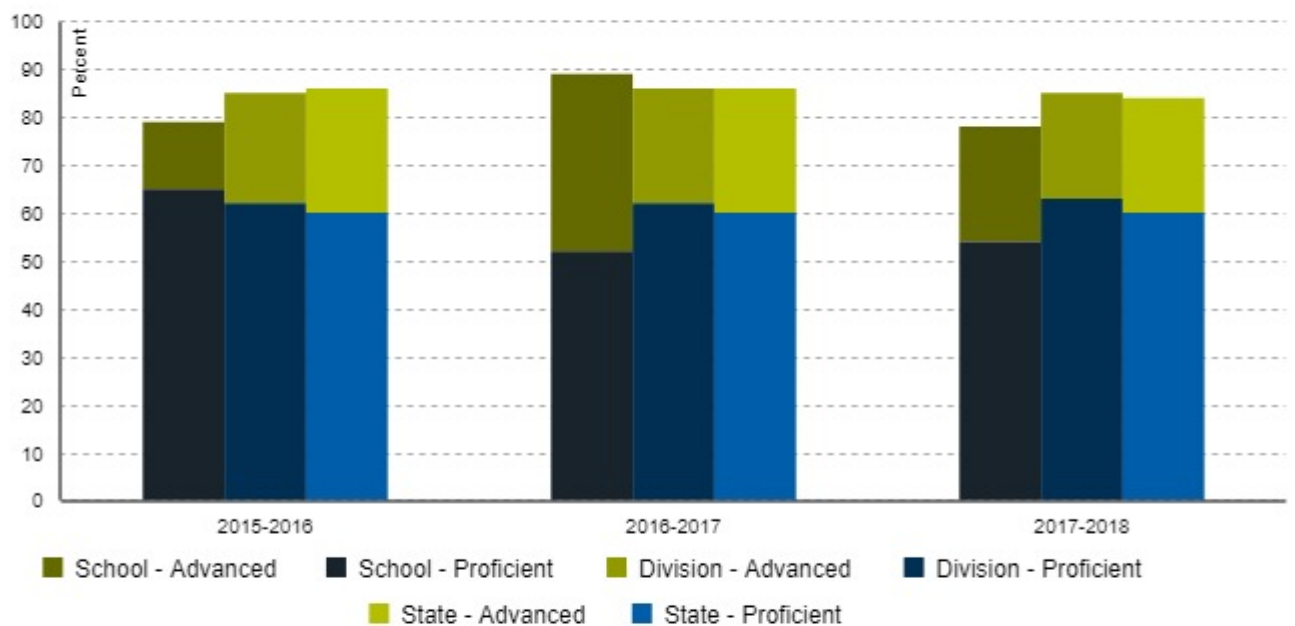

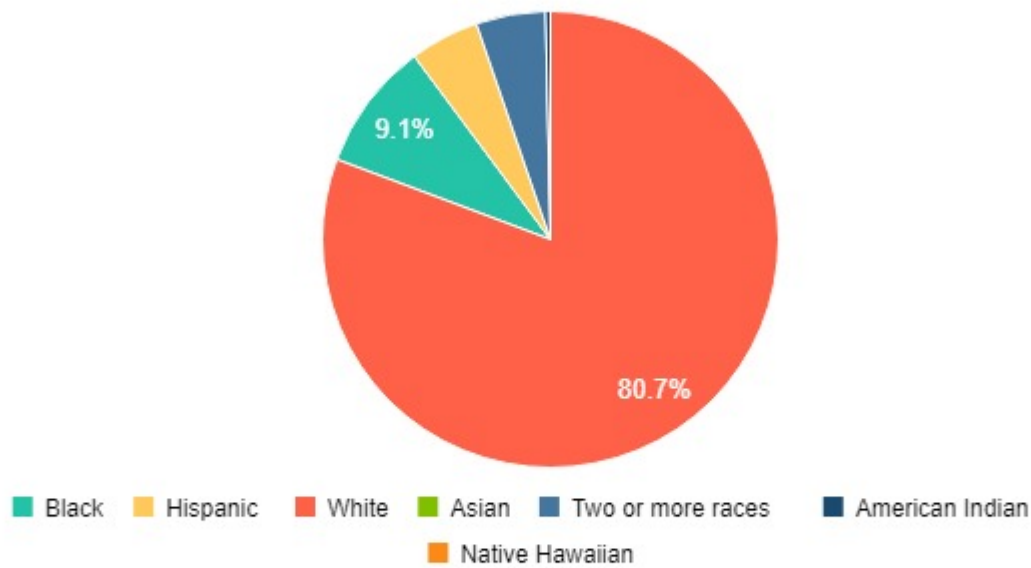

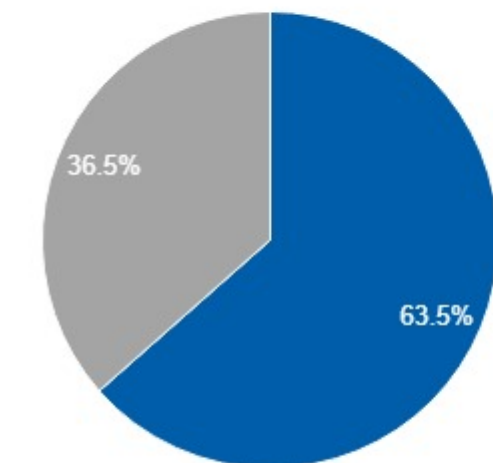
## FALL MEMBERSHIP BY SUBGROUPS

### 2017 Fall Membership By Subgroup: Racial and Ethnic Groups

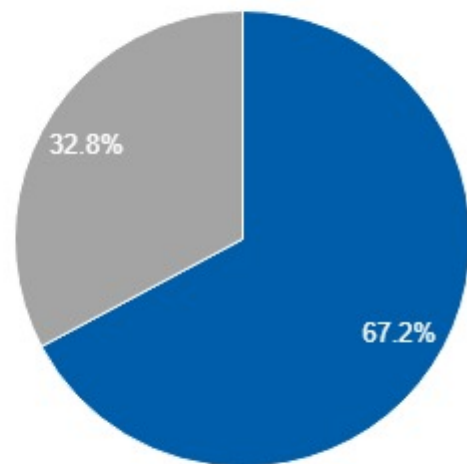


## Percentage of Expenditures

### 2016 - 2017 Division Expenditures      2016 - 2017 Statewide Expenditures



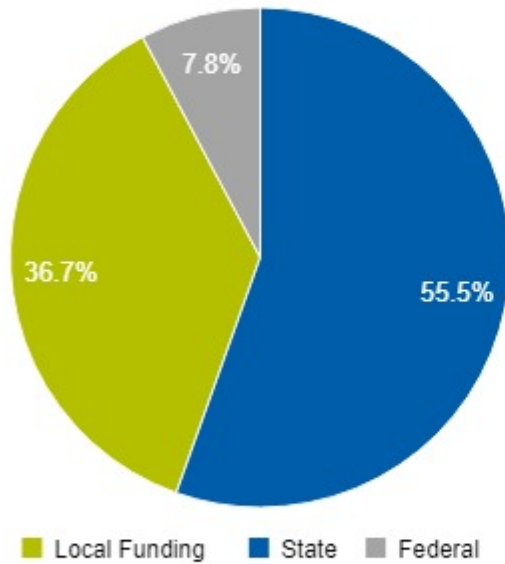

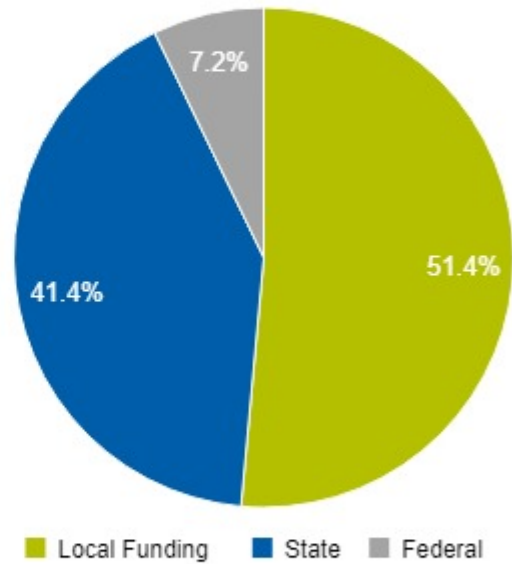

### 2016 - 2017 Division Per-Pupil Spending

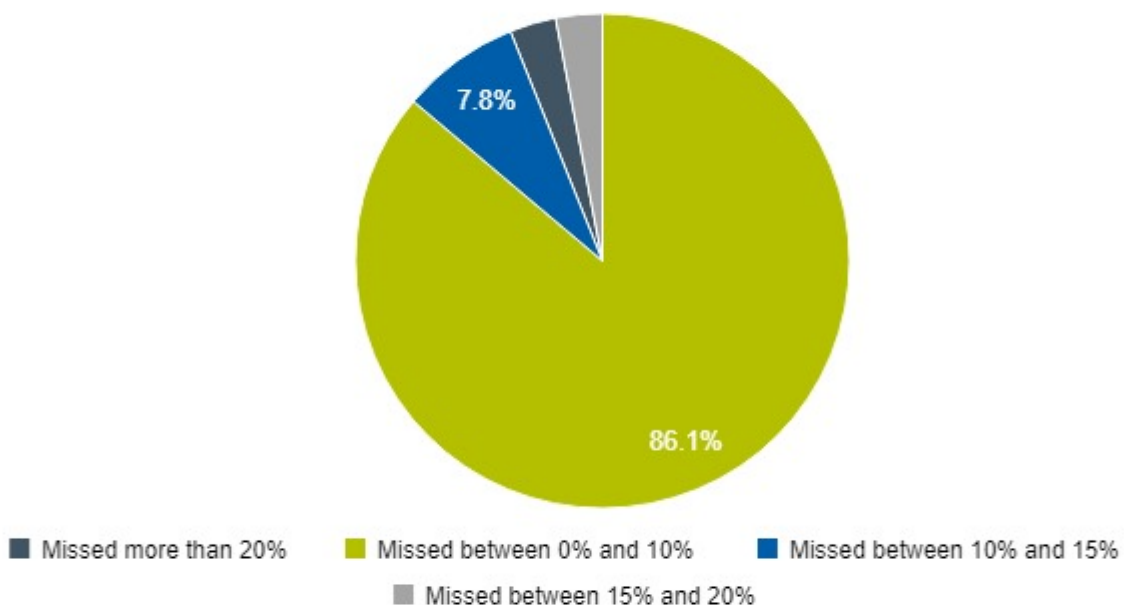


### 2016 - 2017 Statewide Per-Pupil Spending

### Percent of Students Absent 2017-2018 School Year: All Students



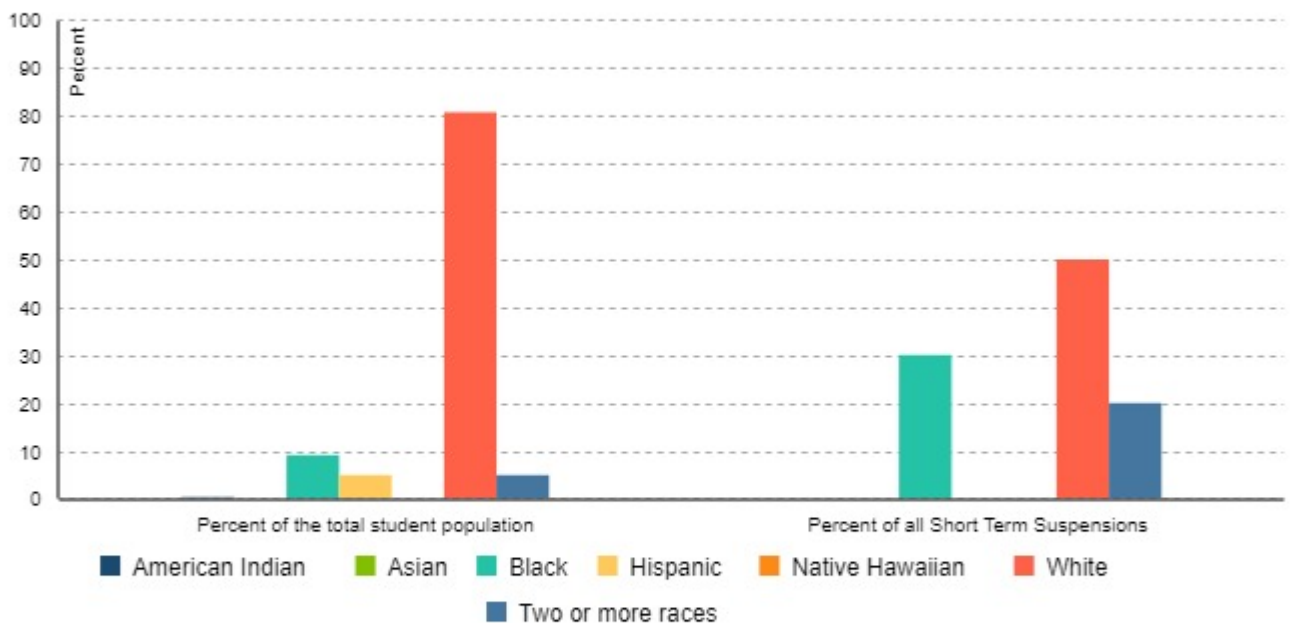

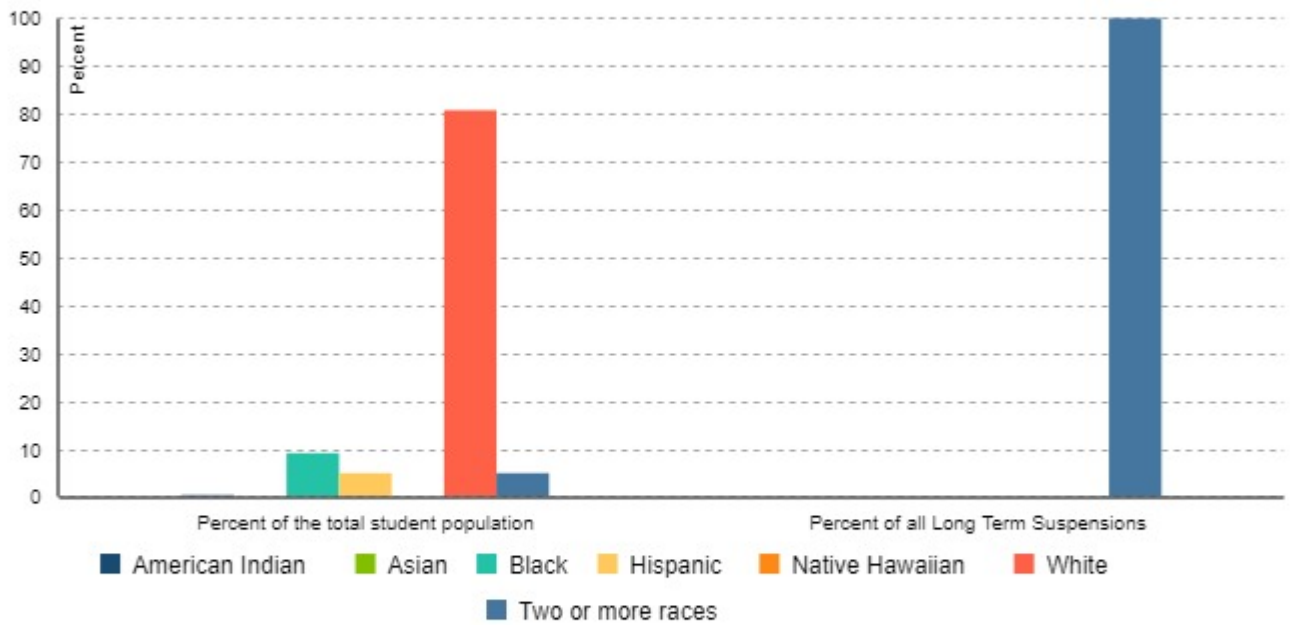
### Short Term Suspensions: 2017-2018





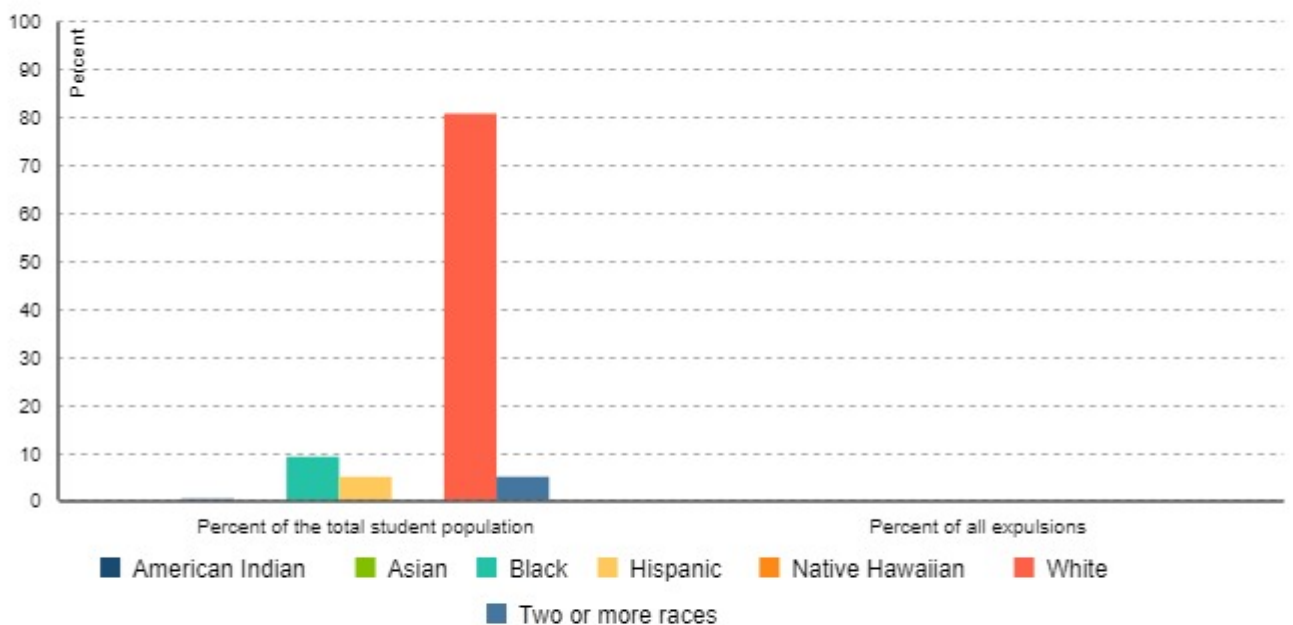

### Long Term Suspensions: 2017-2018



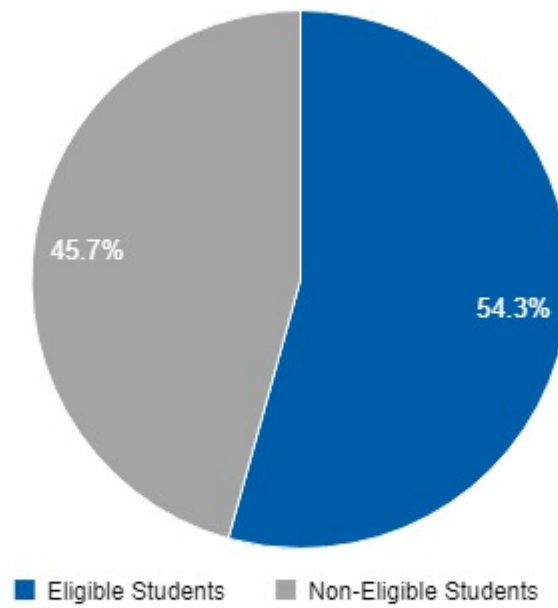

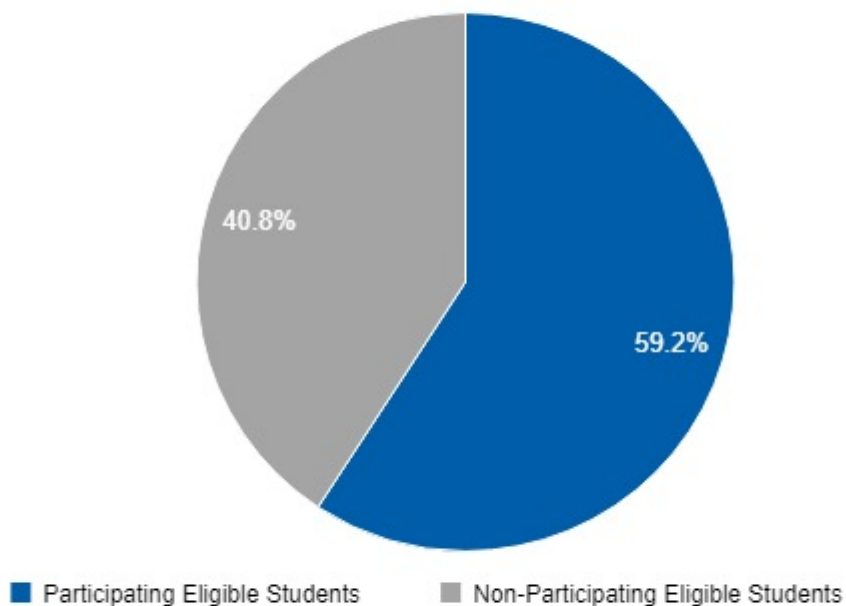

Free and Reduced Meal Eligibility: 2016-2017



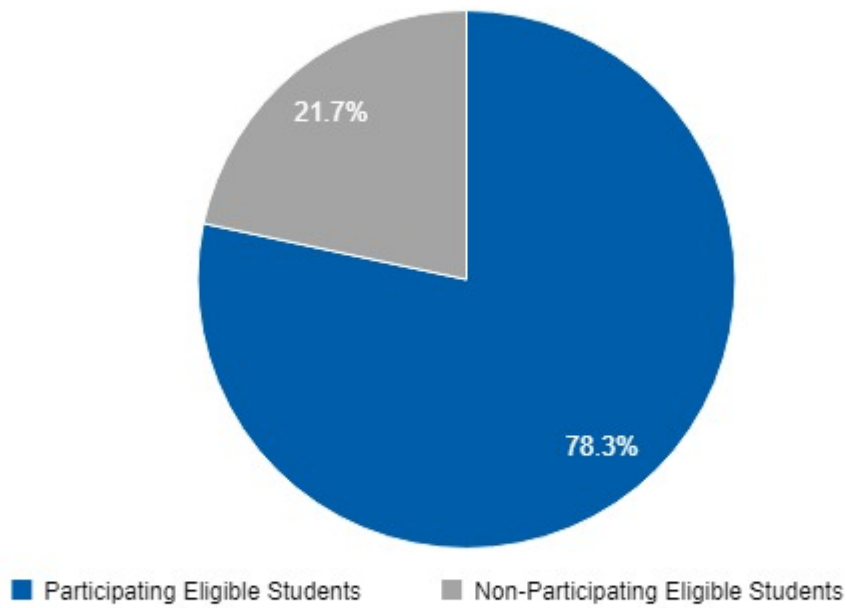
## Free and Reduced Breakfast Participation of Eligible Students
